



How to Resolve ASCII Value Error When Adding New Records

To conform to Windows standard file naming conventions, some ASCII characters are not allowed when adding new vendor ids, part ids, equipment table records, etc. in CFAWin8.

- When using an invalid ASCII character, the following message is displayed:
USER, you cannot use a 'Character Symbol' (ASCII Value =##) in the 'New Equipment#'.

I. When naming vendors, parts, equipment, etc., only use allowed ASCII characters

1. Click "OK" when the error message pops up
2. Rename the file using only the allowed values:
 - i. Numbers 0 – 9
 - ii. Letters A – Z (upper and lower case)
 - iii. Exclamation Point: !
 - iv. At Symbol: @
 - v. Apostrophe: '
 - vi. Dollar Symbol: \$
 - vii. Percent Sign: %
 - viii. Ampersand: &
 - ix. Open Parenthesis: (
 - x. Close Parenthesis:)
 - xi. Equal Sign: =
 - xii. Period: .
 - xiii. Plus Sign: +
 - xiv. Minus Sign: -
 - xv. Underscore: _
 - xvi. Semicolon: ;
