



## Adding Inventory Pictures (JPEGs) to CFAWin

### CFAWin allows you to store JPEG files and view them within the Inventory Table Screen

- The \* located after CFAWin\* refers to the version of CFA being used.
- Any document that can be scanned or saved as a .jpg file can be saved for viewing in CFAWin (i.e. bills of sale, auction documents, accident reports, diagrams, etc.)

#### I. Add Inventory Pictures into CFAWin\*:

1. *Exit out of CFAWin\**
2. *Copy the .jpg file(s)*
  - i. Select the .jpg file(s)
  - ii. Right-click -> Copy
3. *Navigate to the PICTURE folder*
  - i. The folder location is specified on the JPEGs tab in the Inventory Table
4. *Paste the .jpg file(s)*
  - i. Right-click in the PICTURE folder -> Paste
5. *Rename the file(s) using the following convention:*  
**INV\_###\_FileDescription.jpg**

If you have different pictures for the same item located in different stockrooms use the following convention:

**INV\_###\_SS\_FileDescription.jpg**

- ❖ INV = Denotes inventory
- ❖ ### = Part number as listed in inventory table
- ❖ SS = Stockroom location
- ❖ FileDescription = Additional user-defined description (not required)

**Example: INV\_10w30\_01\_Oil1quart.jpg**

#### II. View Inventory Pictures in CFAWin\*:

1. *Start CFAWin\**
2. *Access the Inventory Table screen*
3. *Select the Inventory record with newly added .jpg*
  - i. Select the JPEGs tab at the bottom of the screen
  - ii. Select the .jpg file name in the lower left-hand window to view the picture in the right-hand window if more than one picture saved
